

RETAINERS



Congratulations and SMILE! You have completed your active phase of treatment, and we're proud of you!

IN GENERAL:

- Retainers are forever to ensure stability of your correction.
- Dogs love retainers! They will even chew through your retainer box, so store these in a drawer or up high.
- Retainers wrapped in napkins can be thrown away accidentally. Stuffing them in your pocket or bag can distort them as well. Use the provided retainer box to avoid loss or breakage.
- Each removable retainer costs \$350 to replace. Please be very careful! Repair charges can also apply.
- If a sharp spot develops, use a clean nail file to buff it. Do not use scissors to trim it.
- Brush your retainers with a clean toothbrush and *cold* water to avoid distorting the retainers.
- If your wisdom teeth are being extracted, please resume wearing them the *same* day. Teeth can shift without retainers even when wisdom teeth are gone.
- Due to wear and tear, your retainers will need to be replaced at some point. If they start to feel loose or ill fitting call the office for an evaluation.
- For retainer checks, please call us and bring in *all* retainers for evaluation. These are complimentary!

FIRST RETAINERS (Essix, 1 set):

- These are worn full time (24/7) until your next retainer delivery appointment.
- Remove them for eating, brushing, and wearing a mouthguard. These retainers do not act as mouthguards or nightguards.
- Common adjustments to these retainers include minor speech affect, and not being able to close the teeth together. Keep wearing your retainers in order to adjust quicker.
- Loosening of the retainers will occur over the next few weeks as your gums tighten up, but this will not affect the retainers to hold tooth position.
- Once your new retainers arrive, clean these well and store them as your backup retainers do not throw them away!

FINAL RETAINERS (Luxe, 1 set):

- These retainers are custom fit to your digital model. Now you have 2 sets of retainers!
- These are worn 8-10 hours/night, every night, unless otherwise instructed.
- Use the provided retainer box to store them. Follow the same cleaning instructions as before.
- If you lose or break them and you have been wearing your retainers diligently, call us immediately. We can order replacements from your digital file (fees apply). A virtual consultation may be requested if there are concerns about your alignment. Send images to doctors@allstarsmilesortho.com

OTHER RETAINER OPTIONS:

- You can request a rigid nightguard to replace the upper retainer if you clench or grind your teeth. This will protect your enamel and can relax your jaw muscles. Additional charges apply.
- Fixed (bonded wire) retainers are also an option if you have a stubborn tooth that remembers its old position. There are muscle and bite forces on the teeth, and/or you may have less biological support for certain teeth. You can also elect this retainer if you are worried that you will not keep up with the removable retainers. These are glued behind the front teeth and are semi-permanent. Daily flossing and avoiding hard fruits with your front teeth is advised with this retainer. If these retainers are removed by your dental professional, they should be replaced with a removable retainer.

RETAINER FAQ's:

Q: Why do our teeth want to move?

A: Bones are always changing, more so in growing patients (up to age 25!) and those who have weaker gum support. We also use our teeth to eat, and sometimes we have habits like grinding.

Q: Will wisdom teeth cause shifting?

A: Not if you are wearing retainers. Even when wisdom teeth are removed, retainers must be worn to counteract the daily forces placed on our teeth.

Q: Can I use my clear retainers as a mouthguard?

A: No, please resume wearing a "boil and bite" mouthguard for proper sports injury prevention.

Q: Can I use my clear retainers as bleaching trays?

A: Please consult your dentist about custom bleaching.

Q: Will I need to wear retainers every single night forever?

A: Routine daily wear is advised. To maximize your wear time, please start after dinner on. Each person will have a different biology and bite forces. If you find it is too difficult to stick with a routine, consider switching to a fixed retainer (see above). Retainers are like "eyeglasses for your teeth." If you had vision correction, you wouldn't stop wearing your glasses. You just finished bite correction, please wear your retainers!
